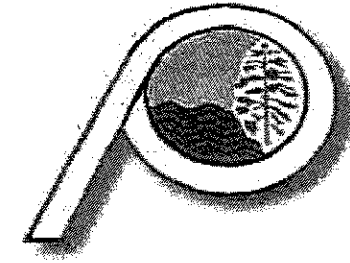

**Facilities: "Where to Play in Perry"**

*SUMMER & WINTER*

**Clear Lake** offers a picnic area, change rooms and washroom facilities. In addition, a large activities field is located opposite the swimming area.

Follow Bay Lake Road to Beach Road. The park is located at end of Beach Road.

**Brook's Falls** is the best kept secret in Perry Township. Aside from being picturesque, you may enjoy walking paths and picnic areas, complete with washroom facilities. The park is located at 690 Deer Lake Road. Follow Hwy 592 to Deer Lake Road. The park is approximately 2.8 km on left.

**Long Lake** has limited facilities and parking at this time. The park is located on Long Lake Road. Follow Boundary Road to Long Lake Road. The park is approximately 3.7 km. on left.

**Emsdale** offers a playground area complete with a picnic table, basketball net, ball field and outdoor rink area. The park is located adjacent to the library at 25 Joseph Street, right off of Hwy 592 in the village of Emsdale. This location hosts public skating and ice hockey during the winter months.

**Novar** offers playground facilities complete with a picnic table, ball field and an outdoor rink. The park is located behind the Novar Fire Hall at 54 McCrandle Street. Follow Boundary Road to McCrandle Street. This location hosts public skating and ice hockey during the winter and the annual ball hockey league in the spring.

**\*\*Please Note:** There is no lifeguard on duty at any of our public swimming areas. Be safe. Be smart. Do not take risks and never swim alone.

*SPRING THRU FALL*

The Park-to-Park, multi-use trail system has access points at Station Road (by the railway tracks) and Rochester Lake Road and Kearney Road area.
