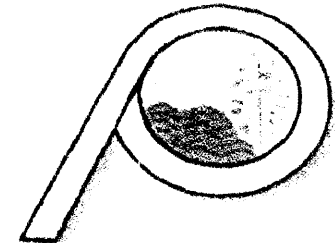

SUMMER & WINTER

Clear Lake: Offers a picnic area, change rooms and washroom facilities as well as a large activities field right off Beach Road opposite the swimming area. Take Bay Lake Road to Beach Road. Located at end of Beach Road.

Brook's Falls: Located on Deer Lake Road is the best kept secret in Perry Twp. Aside from being picturesque, you may enjoy walking paths and picnic areas complete with washroom facilities. Take Hwy. 592 N to Deer Lake Road. Turn right. Park located 2.8 km on left.

Long Lake: Located on Long Lake Road in Novar this site has limited facilities and parking at this time. From Novar, take Boundary Road to Long Lake Road. Park is approximately 3.7 km. on left.

Emsdale: Offers a playground area complete with picnic table right beside the library as well as a basketball hoop, ball fields and an outdoor rink area, right off of Hwy 592 N in the village of Emsdale. Public skating and ice hockey take place at this location in winter.

Novar: Offers playground facilities complete with picnic table, adjacent to a ball field and an outdoor rink right behind the Novar Firehall on McCrandle Street. Take Boundary Road to McCrandle St. Turn right. Located just a bit further ahead on left hand side. Public skating and ice hockey take place at this location in winter.

****Please Note:** There is no lifeguard on duty at any of our public swimming areas. Be safe. Be smart. Do not take risks and never swim alone.

SPRING THRU FALL

The Park-to-Park, multi-use trail system has access points at Station Road (by the railway tracks) and Rochester Lake Road and Kearney Road area.
